Peggy was a very caring person always willing to help anyone in trouble.

#### **Rev Cannon Sally Davies** has written this tribute to Peggy and the work she did in our church family.

When Edward and I arrived at Christ Church to begin our incumbency we were introduced to the two church wardens, Gerald Bradnum and Peggy Ingamells.

Together they formed a partnership for which we will

always be grateful. As church wardens they were caring, loyal and hard working, giving a great deal to Christ Church.

Peggy was born in Brighton in 1936. She grew up in Slough in her parents' grocery shop. When her father served for 6 years as a 'desert rat', Peggy helped in the shop.

Peggy had one brother, John. When Peggy was 12 years old the family moved to Bradford.

She married Wilf and lived in Manchester for 22 years and had two children, Karl and Sally, and later two grandchildren, John and Peter.

Peggy trained as a radiographer at Bradford Royal Infirmary and radiography became her career. She was involved in the development of a hip replacement which is widely used today.

She worked in a Jewish Hospital, a private practice in Manchester, where her patients were Granada Studio stars and Manchester United soccer club. Cont. next page
