We are so privileged to have Owen sing for us in Christ Church. As well as singing in Christ Church he also regularly sings in Llandaff Cathedral choir.

Earlier this year, 13yr old Owen was shortlisted from hundreds of entrants across the UK for the BBC Young Chorister of the Year competition. The contest, for BBC Songs of Praise and Radio 2, was recorded in Salisbury Cathedral just before half term. 5 boys and 5 girls competed in separate semi-finals for 6 places (3 boys and 3 girls) in the final, which will be broadcast on Sunday 5th Dec at 12.30pm on BBC1.

Both semi-finals can be viewed on iplayer if you missed them.

Don't forget to watch the final on Sunday 5th December.

The competition is very strong but we feel that Owen has a great chance of winning.

ALSO ..... Owen successfully auditioned to sing solo in the production of the Snowman in St David's Hall on 9th December.

He will sing in the matinee performance.

## Siôn Brynach our Curate writes ...



Siôn Brynach has been part of the Christ Church community since May 2019 and became our curate upon ordination as a Deacon in June 2020. In May 2021 he was given six months leave of absence by the Bishop of Llandaf, but now

returns to his ministry at Christ Church.

I was delighted to meet with Bishop June a few weeks ago and be given her blessing to resume my ministry as curate here at Christ Church. When I'd met her previously, back in May, she had rightly decided that I would benefit from six months away from ministry to concentrate on the needs of our family.

In October 2020, while walking along a pavement in Canton, Cardiff, Catherine my wife was involved in a serious collision when a van failed to stop at a Tjunction, collided with a car parked opposite which in turn crushed Catherine against an adjacent wall. She suffered life-threatening and life-changing injuries. Since then she has had 4 visits to theatre for surgery – three times at the University Hospital in Cardiff, and most recently – 1 September - at the Royal Free Hospital in London. Her rehab continues and the road between Cardiff and her Burton-on-Trent clinic has become disturbingly familiar to us both.

The lesson of the past year for me has been the sustaining nature of the discipline of discipleship – the daily pattern of morning and evening prayer. God does indeed give us our daily bread, through prayer and the scriptures. So often the day's readings have given me what I needed to hear (though some-

times didn't want to hear!) that particular day.

It hasn't all been doom and gloom. Catherine and I were hugely proud that Mali our 18 year old daughter managed to get excellent A level results despite all the stresses and challenges we've faced. She began studying French, German and Italian at Bangor University in September. A month later our 21 year old son, Pwyll, began his training as a commercial pilot at Gatwick. The application and assessment process took two years, and we're so proud of Pwyll that he managed to get a place on this course. 15 year old Amig and 12 year old Mael have also been stars and demonstrated their resilience.

It has been a great help this past six months to have been able to concentrate on the family, but I've missed you all. Now I look forward both to seeing you at the Christ Church's building and to renewing my contact with the wider worshipping community through PodChurch and the zoom spiritual communion.
